Minimum requirements for a Neighbourhood Watch

1. Vigilance

Be vigilant. Call the police on 114 14 if you notice any suspicious activity, or call 112 to report a crime in progress. Any reports that are not emergencies can be made via www.polisen.se.

2. If you go away

Tell your neighbours you're going away.

3. Valuables

Store valuables securely – there are no safe places that thieves won't find.

4. Preventative measures

How can we increase **safety** in our building?



The aim of a Neighbourhood Watch (**Grannsamverkan**) is to reduce crime and increase safety in your building, leading to greater comfort and peace of mind.

To start a Neighbourhood Watch in your apartment building, contact your neighbours to ask who is interested. Alternatively, you can ask your landlord or housing cooperative board to contact the other residents. If there is sufficient interest, the next step is to contact the local police to establish a Neighbourhood Watch.
